How to receive BBC iPlayer and ITVplayer on your computer here in Austria or anywhere else in the world. If you have already tried to view these programmes you will have certainly had a message saying not available in your area unless you were in the UK or have a UK computer. With your iPlayer you will be able to view BBC1, BBC2, BBC3, BBC4, HD, BBC News Live 24 hrs a day, BBC Parliament plus a few more.

Also ITV1, ITV2, ITV3, ITV4

The use of these iPlayers allow you to view BBC or ITV programmes, live or something that has been screened, yesterday, last week or a few months ago. There are also a big library of all the old favourites from years gone by. Maybe you want to see last Saturdays 'Match of the Day' or one of the recent films, the scope is enormous.

First you will have to install expat shield on your computer.

But what is expat shield ?

Ok so now you are a little wiser, so now you have to install Expat Shield on your PC. Click on the following link :-

<http://expatshield.com> Download the software and install it on your PC. An Icon will be laid on your desktop.

When the installation is completed click your Expat Shield Icon to open your browser.

Then type in for BBC [www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer](http://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer) or for ITV [www.itv.com/itvplayer](http://www.itv.com/itvplayer) to open up the iPlayers. You must spend a bit of time following and exploring all the points.

When you are on the BBC iPlayer there is a link to explain the new version of this player, the link [http://iplayerhelp.external.bbc.co.uk/help/information/how\\_to\\_tips](http://iplayerhelp.external.bbc.co.uk/help/information/how_to_tips) can also be clicked if you have your expat shield on.

Like anything new with your pc it may seem a little difficult at first but just play around and you will find a host of interesting programmes. The pictures are mostly in HD and can be viewed full screen or connected to your TV with the correct cable can be viewed there or run through your VCR or HD can be saved for later viewing.
